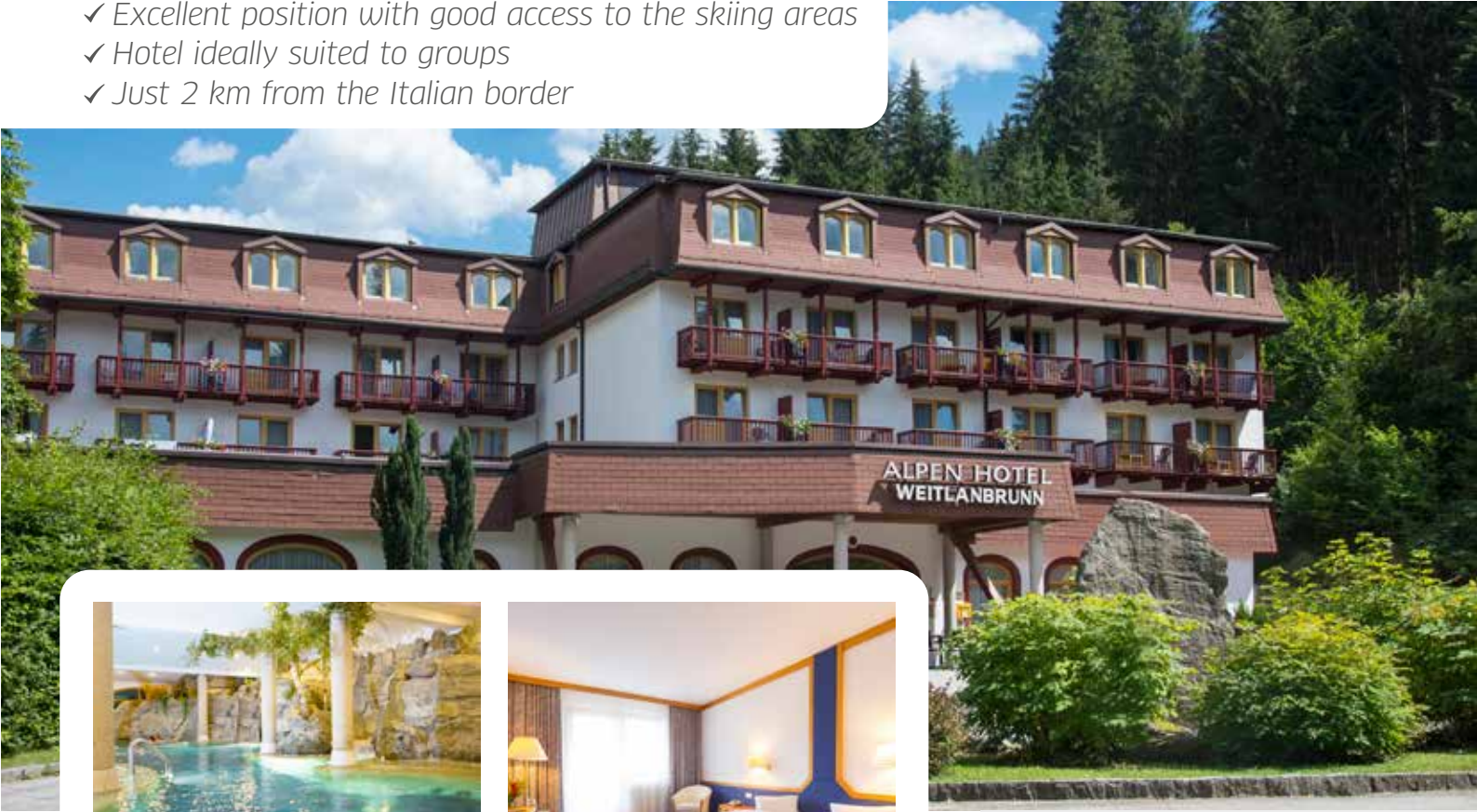

Each week sees a different festival hosted by a different village, each with a specific feature. A vintage train provides the historic means to discover the hidden gems of the hills surrounding Siena.



1 Arrival

2 Montepulciano, Bagno Vignoni and a pecorino cheese tasting in Pienza

- The dignified Renaissance character of the lovely cityscape of Montepulciano is reflected in the countless exquisite palaces, which line the streets. Enjoy the historical flair of Piazza Grande in Montepulciano
- We continue on to Pienza where we visit a pecorino cheese producer and sample this wonderful cheese
- After our tasting, we make our way to Bagno Vignoni where you will find a large thermal pool dominating the main square in the centre. In medieval times and during the Renaissance Bagno Vignoni was a beautiful thermal spa. The picturesque setting of this small spa has attracted many famous artists and filmmakers ever since

3 Visit Cortona to enjoy a typical lunch and on to Arezzo

- We discover Cortona today, a true gem and one of the most important cities of the ancient Etruscans
- We enjoy a tasty lunch of traditional local produce
- We move on to visit Arezzo, where, in particular we will visit the 12th century Church of Santa Maria with its impressive bell tower and the Piazza Grande, which is the venue for the famous "Joust of the Saracens", an annual medieval contest

4 Trip on a vintage steam train to the festival

- Today we take a trip down memory lane as we board our vintage steam train in Siena for a journey into the unique hilly Tuscan countryside
- We pass through the characteristic old villages of the picturesque UNESCO-listed Orcia Valley and steam along the flanks of Italy's second tallest volcano, the 1732 m high Monte Amiata
- The pleasant train journey is a particular highlight as the gentle rattling motion takes us back in time, as we pass through pristine landscapes. We leave our vintage mode of transport at one of several quaint train stations where we give ourselves over to a journey of discovery at one of the region's festivals

The special climate around Lake Como has given rise to a variety of exotic plants. Beautiful villas and splendid gardens can be found on its shores. On this trip, the Rhaetian Railway awaits you, inviting you to a spectacular crossing of the Alps on the legendary Bernina Express route. Through tunnels and several viaducts, the train takes you to the chic resort of St. Moritz.

1 Arrival

2 Como and Lake Como

- Today we will first drive to charming Como on the southern tip of the lake and stroll through the walled old town with its alleyways and boutiques.
- The city's sights include the Duomo, the old Broletto Town Hall and Piazza Cavour, the centre of Como.
- In the afternoon we will take a boat trip on Europe's deepest inland lake to Bellagio, probably the most well known town in the middle of the lake with colourful houses and staircase alleys.

3 Train ride on the Bernina Express line from Tirano to St. Moritz

- After breakfast we travel through the Veltlin to Tirano. Here the Rhaetian Railway is already waiting to take us on an impressive Alpine crossing on the legendary Bernina Express route.
