### 2 The Fishermen Route around the Levico Lake

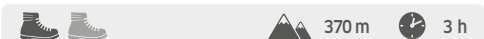

#### 2 Canelli, sparkling wine and Alba

First hiking tour through ancient castles and vineyards to the old town of Canelli. Stop at the place of birth of the first Asti sparkling wine, which has been produced here for over 150 years. Visit of a traditional winery with the characteristic "underground cathedrals" and wine tasting. In the afternoon we visit Alba, the city of the white truffle.

Past poplars and hazelnut woods, the tour ends in Neive; take a stroll along the village's tiny streets that roll up in circles, hugging the ancient castle. In the afternoon stop at a farmhouse for a truffle hunt followed by a tasting of local products together with wines of the region.
